What programs are we looking for?

VoteTilla Programs should educate and inform the audience about the history of woman suffrage. They may focus on a particular person (or group of people), a specific location, or an event related to the woman suffrage movement in New York State, particularly the period from 1830-1917. Programs may also focus on a related social reform issue from the period or “unfinished business” from the 1848 Declaration of Sentiments.

Important Information: Please read the following guidelines before beginning to complete the form.

Q: Who needs to complete and submit this form?

A: This process is open to both individuals and organizations who wish to present a program as a featured element of our week-long agenda. Featured programs will be presented on the boats, as we move along the canal, or at landing sites. Some featured programs may be presented more than once or at more than one site during the week.

Here are some examples of the programming we hope to include:

Dramatic presentations (from 5 min. to 30 min.)

Lectures (up to 30 min.)

Music, dance, and other performances (up to 30 min.)

Visual arts exhibits

(expectations and needs for set-up and take-down must be outlined)

Re-enactors: presenters should be prepared to stay in character, deliver key speeches, and interact with VoteTilla guests and audiences on the boats and/or at landing sites

Panel discussions (up to 30 min.)
